## **Minutes of the Carlsbad Historical Society Annual Meeting and Program 30th Anniversary, September 10, 2005**

The annual meeting was held at Heritage Hall in Magee Park. It was preceded by a Champagne Brunch at 10 AM. Approximately 45 members were in attendance. The annual meeting was called to order at 11 AM. President Susan Gutierrez welcomed all members and then made some brief announcements: A ceremony honoring the memory of 9/11 would be held at 9 AM Sunday Sept. 11 at Fire Station 5; the Barrio Festival would be held on Roosevelt St. on that date also; a Memorial Service for Ann L'Heureux, long-time Historical Society member and contributor, would be held on Sat. Sept. 17. Following that, current President Gutierrez and current Vice-Presidents Hubert Smith and

Phyllis Demy were re-elected unanimously for another year.

Following that, Marge Howard-Jones presented a program on historic Carlsbad architecture. All attendees were given an 8 page program of photographs of historic Carlsbad homes, along with the brochure "Historic Carlsbad – A Self-Guided Tour".

The program ended at approximately 12 PM, after which any members who wished could tour the Magee Barn, opened especially for the occasion.
