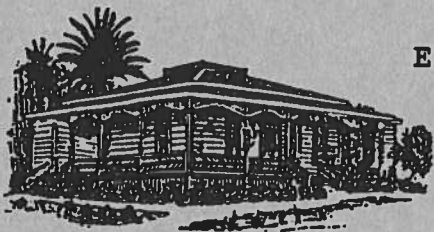

At our 7:30 a.m. Board meeting held Tuesday, January 5th at the Harding Center, the following business was transacted:

We welcomed Eleanore Hardman who will serve as Vice President and Orpha Froblom as Secretary.

An honorary life membership will be given to Alan and Joan Kindle in recognition for their years of work in the restoration of Leo Carrillo's Ranch and its becoming a dedicated Community Park. It also voted to support the Friends of Carrillo Ranch Inc. in its effort for access to the park coming off Carrillo Way. Two public meetings will be held on this issue Jan/11 and Jan/18 at 5:00 p.m. Council Chambers. Members are encouraged to attend the meetings.

The Park and Recreation Department asked The Society if it would like to provide a plaque at the cost of \$250, to be hung in Heritage Hall, Magee Park relating the history of this historical building. On Sept. 25, 1942 President dedicated what is the world's largest amphibious-assault training site, an environmental preserve as well, with its own buffalo herd and wild life manager.

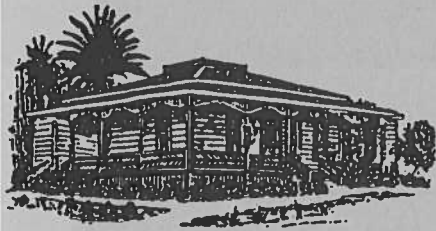

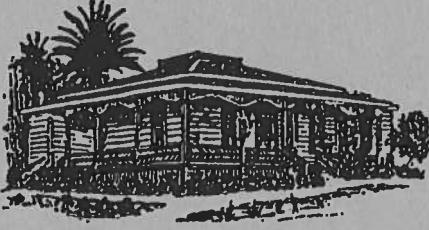

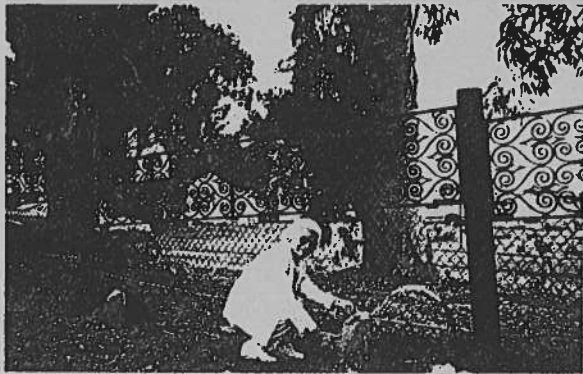

Twelve noon, you'll enjoy a sit-down luncheon...world-famed Pea-soup, a savory warm chicken pasta salad, strawberry shortcake, and coffee or ice tea.

In 1883 John A. Frazier used his gift of divining and tapped into an artesian spring at 400 feet. A second well, at a little over 500 feet, produced a stream of mineral water. It proved identical in mineral content to Karlsbad, Bohemia. The famed spa, now is called Karlovy Vary, Czechoslovakia.

Today, 101 years following Fraizer's find, another seeker of the spring LUDVIK GRIGORAS will discuss the reopening of the well located at Alt Karlsbad that gave our city its name.

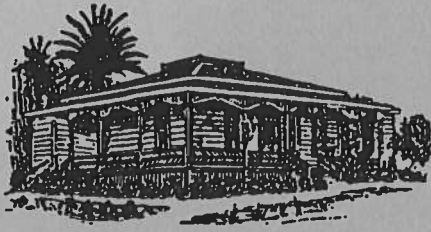
Grigoras was born in Karlsbad, where he lived until 1968. After the Russian invasion, he resided in Germany. In 1970 he moved to New York working for Honeywell, Inc. Transferred to Puerto Rico in 1973, Grigoras worked as an Instrumentation engineer. The following year he came back to Chicago and worked for Honeywell all over the USA and the world until 1984. In 1985, Ludvik and his wife Veronica moved to Corona, Calif. Four years later he was allowed to visit Karlovy Vary. Besides starting the Sister City pact, he worked on historical building restoration and building new hotels.

In June 1993 Grigoras started working with Kay Christiansen on reopening the Carlsbad Mineral Spring and struck mineral water at 400 feet. He will reveal plans to bottle the water and additional projects related to the mineral water.

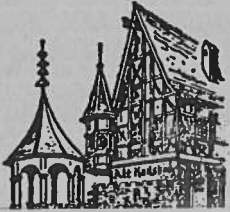
